## On Mission Together Matthew 28:18-20

*For the Christ follower, living on mission with God is no mere quirky interpretation of a single Bible verse; it is a recognition of the \_\_\_\_\_ underlying our very purpose.*

**Discussion 1.** To you, what difference does it make that our Great Commission is based upon “all authority in Heaven and earth”? Does that motivate you more towards missional living? Why or why not?

*Genuine Christ followers are \_\_\_\_\_ in making disciples who are making disciples who are making disciples. I may identify as a Christian without this, but I am not patterning my life after Christ’s without it.*

**Discussion 2.** Different people are discipled differently. What is effective with one person may or may not be particularly effective with another. In your experience, what discipleship has been effective in shaping you? What have you found to be effective in shaping others?

*For Christ followers, a critical part of making disciples is learning (and teaching) how to live life in \_\_\_\_\_ with God’s Spirit, being constantly transformed in heart and mind along the way.*

**Discussion 3.** Do you think it is possible to have my salvation in place without being involved in any kind of spiritual formation (or transformation) at all? Do you think Western Christianity places too little emphasis on spiritual formation or discipleship?

*When we say, “I’ll be with you in spirit” it mostly just means we won’t be there. But when Jesus said, “Lo, I am with you always,” it meant everything was about to \_\_\_\_\_ for His followers.*

**Discussion 4.** Under what circumstances do you most often feel the presence of God’s Spirit in or with you? Under what circumstances do you have the most trouble feeling God’s presence?

**Discussion 5.** How does this lesson cause you to pray? How does it prepare your heart for worship?
