## Faithfulness

### 2 Chronicles 7:11-22

*In our journey with God, \_\_\_\_\_ is a game changer (His to us and ours to Him). And He proves His faithfulness to us long before we are called upon to demonstrate ours to Him.*

**Discussion 1. What are some ways God has proven His faithfulness to you? Why is it important to stop and remind ourselves of this on a regular basis?**

*One of the ways God encourages our faithfulness is to remind us of our heartfelt \_\_\_\_\_ back when we began our faith walk with Him. He loves us enough to hold us to those vows.*

**Discussion 2. Can you recall your feelings of surrender when you first started following Christ? How would you describe them? How have they grown since then?**

*Christ followers need not speak Hebrew nor Greek to understand God's Word; we have Christ's Spirit living in us. Our problem is not that we don't understand God, it is that we do not WANT to understand God. It is a \_\_\_\_\_.*

**Discussion 3. What is the difference between asking the meaning of scripture and asking what I WANT the meaning of scripture to be? Why is the second question such an important question to examine?**

*God's Word clarifies for us that our choices have consequences. It even clarifies for us what those choices should be and that rebellious choices likewise will have consequences. That's not fear mongering...it is just \_\_\_\_\_.*

**Discussion 4. When God says, "if you do this, then these bad things will happen to you", does that feel manipulative to you? Or does it feel like love to you? To you, what is the difference between those two things?**

**Discussion 5. How does this lesson cause you to pray? How does it prepare your heart for worship?**
