More About Stewardship Luke 16:1-18

Want to make an impact on eternity, rather than just on this temporal world? Leverage your resources for the of, because many of those "others" will be with you in eternity.
Discussion 1. What are some examples of leveraging your resources for the benefit of others? What "resources" do you think that includes? How does that make an impact in eternity?
My relationship with money, i.e., how, where, why and on whom I spend it, is a pretty of my values and priorities; and those, in turn, say much about my relationship with God and His kingdom.
Discussion 2. Do you think your finances paint a fair picture of what is important to you, i.e., of your values and priorities? Why or why not? When you hold your finances before the Lord for discussion, what is one thing you feel He is telling you?
Jesus taught that our attitude towards wealth and possessions, like everything else, comes down to an issue of the From God's perspective, it is less about what outward behavior suggests and much more about what the heart feels.
Discussion 3. All of us think, to one degree or another, about "managing perception", i.e., doing things to impact how others see us. But what about God's perspective of us? What does that require of us? And what about how we perceive ourselves? What does that require of us?
God's law will not save us; that is a free gift from God. But His law helps us know how to, once we are saved. "What does love look like?" is an important question, both in our relationship with God and in our relationships with others.
