Structure for Transformation Mark 3:13-19

Discussion 1. Why do you suppose small groups are such powerful vehicles for real spiritual transformation? What do you see as some of the benefits that make them so effective at bringing about life change?

Discussion 2. Who is your small group, gathering together around the Word and learning together? How did God lead you to that group?
