## Whose Story We are Telling 2 Chronicles 6:1-11

**Discussion 3. Think about someone you know who is good at spiritual growth and transformation in themselves; what are some things that make them good at it? What disciplines do they follow that most people do not? What is one of those disciplines that you yourself want to get better at?**
