Gaining God's Perspective Daniel 9:23-27

The reason it is so difficult for us to wait on God's timing is that we have no idea just He intends to accomplish in our lives
idea just He intends to accomplish in our lives in order to best answer our little prayers.
Discussion 1. We are all waiting on God's timing right now with this Coronavirus. In the midst of this waiting, what unexpected "perspective" has God given you, either on yourself, or on others, or on the world around us?
For the Christ follower, Jesus represents God's perfect and pervasive for all sin for all time. Period.
Discussion 2. That Jesus' death and resurrection free us from our bondage to sin, i.e., that our sins no longer identify us, how does that change your day to day life? What difference does it make in your attitude about yourself? About others?
When we begin to see the world through God's eyes, our perspective on all that seemed important to us changes. Suddenly all our political woes and cultural divisions lose their significance and we adjust our eyes to
Discussion 3. Coronaviruses and vaccines and presidential elections are all important to God. But what are some things that are more important to Him? Why is it important for us as Christ followers to keep that perspective?
Our perspective on these current circumstances may feel life-altering, even world-altering; God's perspective is likely much and much than ours. His is better.
Discussion 4. When you pray, how does God speak to you? What role does scripture play in your prayer life?
Discussion 5. How does this lesson cause you to pray? How does it prepare your heart for worship?
