

## **Eyes to See** **Ephesians 1:15-23**

*The promise to us as Christ followers is not just knowledge about God; it is wisdom and discernment about what “knowledge” is true and about how to \_\_\_\_\_ to our lives.*

**Discussion 1.** In your own walk with God, how does the Spirit shape your thoughts and your desires toward wisdom; i.e., what does the Spirit use to help you know truth? Is there something required of you in order for that process to work?

*Unless God opens our eyes to see and our minds to conceive, we simply \_\_\_\_\_ the immense depth and breadth of the spiritual blessings we receive as Christ followers.*

**Discussion 2.** Can you share about a time when you prayed for God to open someone’s spiritual eyes? Why is this such an important prayer? Describe a relationship in your life for whom you should pray this today?

*The profound spiritual truths to which the Spirit of God leads us as believers include Christ’s \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ in the universe as well as His centrality to our faith.*

**Discussion 3.** How does understanding Christ’s supremacy and authority help keep us on mission in the church? What happens if and when we lose sight of his supremacy or authority?

*The fullness of God rests in Jesus, and the fullness of Jesus rests in His \_\_\_\_\_. This is why the proposition that I want Jesus, but I do not want His church simply makes no sense.*

**Discussion 4.** More and more people in our culture say that, though they love Jesus, they want nothing to do with church. How would you counsel someone like that? Why, to you, is Christian community necessarily a part of the Christian walk?
