Discussion 3. Can you think of an example of God's Word being different from your lived experience? How do you reconcile the difference?

Discussion 4. Have you ever had an encounter with God which frightened you? Describe it. What did it teach you about God? Do you a sense for why God chose that particular time to reveal that to you?
