## **Reminders**

### **2 Peter 1:12-15**

*This broken world's pull on our hearts and minds is significant. We need regular, steady doses of God's Word in order to keep \_\_\_\_\_ before us, reminding us that there is so much more reality than what this material world shows us.*

**Discussion 1. What are some specific ways our world/culture pulls you away from the spiritual realities of scripture? How do you combat those pressures?**
